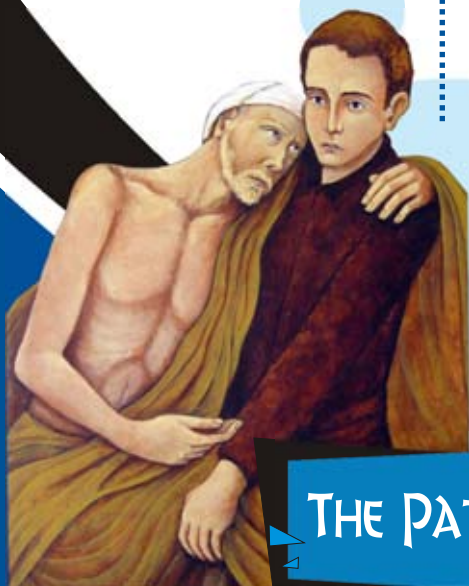
Welcome

THE PATRON



The College is named after St Aloysius Gonzaga who is a model for all the students. This 16th century prince, heir to the throne of the Marquisate of Gonzaga in Italy, at the age of 18 abdicated his rights and entered the Jesuit Order to be a religious whose wealth would be God alone and whose happiness would be the service of others.

While Aloysius was still in training, a plague broke out in Rome, Victims of the plague had no hope of recovery and were being abandoned everywhere for fear of contagion. The youthful Aloysius, who was then 24, rose up to the occasion with his companions and immediately set about caring for the sick and the dying, risking his own life. The risk, however, was too great. Aloysius became a victim of the disease and died in the midst of his noble work, offering his life as a sacrifice for others.

It is the example of his life, pure and noble, not seeking the glories of this world but genuinely concerned about the good of others that is proposed to you as a model here.

THE COLLEGE CREST



To keep before you always the aims of your education in this College and the heights to which you must aspire, you have the Crest and the Motto of this Institution.

General Candidates

Any one who has 85% and above marks in 10th Std will be offered full fee concession.

For Minority Students

Any one who has scored 75% and above in 10th Std will be offered full fee concession.

For SC/ST Candidates

Any one who has scored 70% and above in 10th Std will be offered full fee concession.

The two year Pre-University Course, under the regulation of the board of the Pre-University Examination in Karnataka, is offered by the college with the above combination of subjects for commerce students.

EXAMINATION

The College conducts regular tests and examinations. Following each test and examination parents will be informed about the progress of the student. Academic assistance and counselling will be provided as per the needs of the students. In addition to regular tests and exams the College has a provision for re-examinations for slow learners.

REMEDIAL EDUCATION

The College assists slow learners in achieving their goals through remedial classes and constant encouragement. Regular coaching classes and tests are conducted during and after College hours.

BRIDGE COURSE IN ENGLISH

Students who find English challenging will be offered a bridge course, to enhance their skills in Communicative English, and their capacity to understand the language. The course trains students in the following areas: 1. Grammar 2. Spoken Skills 3. Reading Skills 4. Vocabulary Enhancement and 5. Writing Skills. **The Course is also open to the public.**

ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS

The College conducts special courses to prepare students for entrance examinations of professional institutes. Separate courses are organized for CET, NEET, JEE, COMED K, CPT, CS & CLAT.

ADMISSION PROCESS:

Application forms for PUC are available in the College Office.

- Application forms should be filled in, complete with regard to all the information asked for, in the candidate's own handwriting.
- Application forms should be registered at the College office and a receipt should be obtained by the due date.
- The candidates are discouraged from approaching third person and producing recommendation letters to obtain admission. Please be aware of persons who promise admission and demand money from you. Please inform the Principal about such matters.
- Original documents have to be submitted to the office when the documents are received from the Board. Please keep ready photo copies of the original documents.
- Foreign students cannot be admitted unless they have student/long term visas.
- The admitted candidates should pay the fees immediately after the interview, failing which, they will lose their admission. Selected candidates who do pay the fees or after paying the fees do not attend classes for five consecutive days without intimation, will forfeit their seats. The fees, once paid, will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- Students who come from economically poor backgrounds and would like to avail scholarships are required to meet the Principal.
- Candidates who are found to have obtained admission by false representation will be summarily dismissed with forfeiture of fees.
- **Govt Fee Regulation :** Tuition fees and special fees for the year are payable in one installment. A receipt signed and dated by one who is deputed by the Principal shall be granted for fee paid.

PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED FOR APPLYING

1. a) Applications must be completely filled and registered in the College Office as soon as the SSLC results are declared. (Incomplete applications will be considered disqualified)
- b) Students need not wait for the original Marks Card to apply for admission. Falsification of marks will lead to dismissal with forfeiture of fees.
- c) Students of ICSE/CBSE Board, NRI's/Other States also must apply as soon as their results are declared with a provisional Marks Card without waiting for the original Marks Card. (See the procedure in the college notice board)

ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE:

Applicants from outside India (Gulf and other countries) are expected to bring the Eligibility Certificate from the Pre-University Board, Bangalore. For Further Details contact the College office.

Applicants from within India (i.e. other Boards) are expected to pay Rs. 600/- as eligibility fee at the College Office and need not produce the Eligibility Certificate.

Sports: Students who have represented the State or the Country in Sports and Games will have special preference for seats during admission.
